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**2020-21 School Profile**

**COMMUNITY**

Pecatonica School District is a rural community, covering 76.4 square miles. The district has three schools - an elementary, middle and high school with a total enrollment of 888 students. The high school has an enrollment of 292 students, with an attendance rate of 95% and a low income rate of 26%.

**CURRICULUM**

Classes are held daily on a traditional 8-period schedule with 42 minute class periods. 28 credits are required to graduate, with each year-long class earning 1 credit. A maximum load is 8 credits per year.

- Course requirements for graduation include: 4 credits of English, 3 credits of math, 3 credits of science, 3 credits of social science (World Geography, American History, American Government/Economics), 3.5 credits of PE, 0.5 credit of Health, and 1 credit in vocational, fine arts, or foreign language.

AP courses are offered in Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, English Literature & Composition, Physics, and AP U.S. Government. Dual Credit programs are available through both Rock Valley College (Running Start) and Highland Community College (CollegeNOW). Students in these programs take all classes junior and/or senior year on the college campus.

**GRADING**

**Spring 2020 COVID-19 Information** - Remote learning was worth 30% of a student's overall Semester 2 grades. Students who did not engage in remote learning during this time received a grade of NC (No Credit). A grade of NC only affects credit earned, not GPA.

Letter grades are reported on transcripts using a non-weighted 4.0 scale. No rank is provided. One honor (weighted) point is added to any AP class taken. This is used at graduation to recognize students graduating with honors - summa cum laude (4.0+), magna cum laude (3.75-3.99), or cum laude (3.5-3.74).
